

由2021年11月7日起,《道路交通條例》(第374章)(簡稱《條例》)第56條指明的動物擴闊至涵蓋貓隻和狗隻。如司機駕駛車輛時發生意外而涉及貓隻或狗隻受傷,司機須停車,及向在場的動物畜養人提供資料,或盡快向警方報告。此舉可讓在交

通意外中受傷的貓隻和狗隻得到及時的治療。
With effect from 7 November 2021, the scope of animal specified in section 56 of the Road Traffic Ordinance (Cap. 374) is expanded to include "cat" and "dog". This means that a driver whose vehicle is involved in an accident in which a cat or a dog is injured must stop the vehicle and give his/her particulars to the keeper of the animal, if present, or report the accident to the Police as soon as possible. This will enable the cat or dog which has been injured in a traffic accident to receive timely medical attention.


